## That's what you need

Natural colour\*

Fine model plaster

Mixing vessel

Sticks for mixing

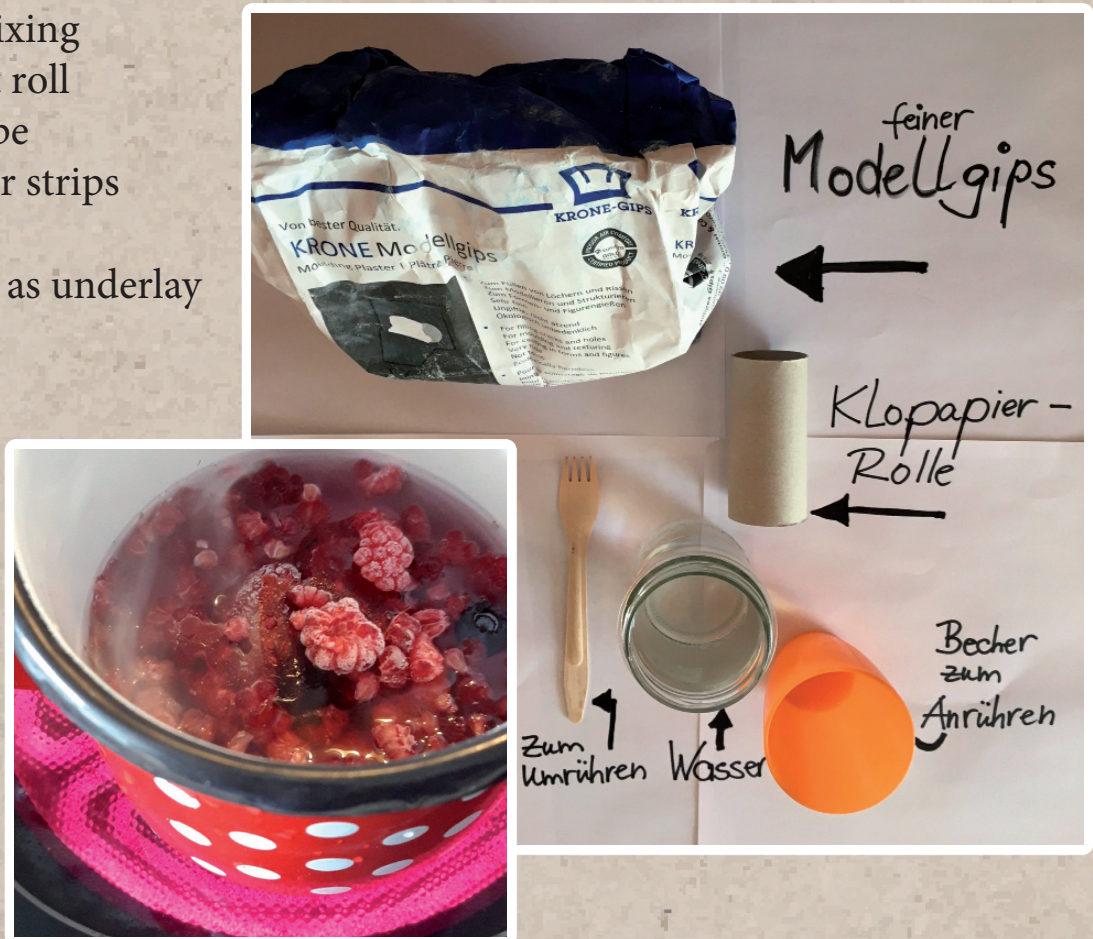
Empty toilet roll

Adhesive tape

Baking paper strips

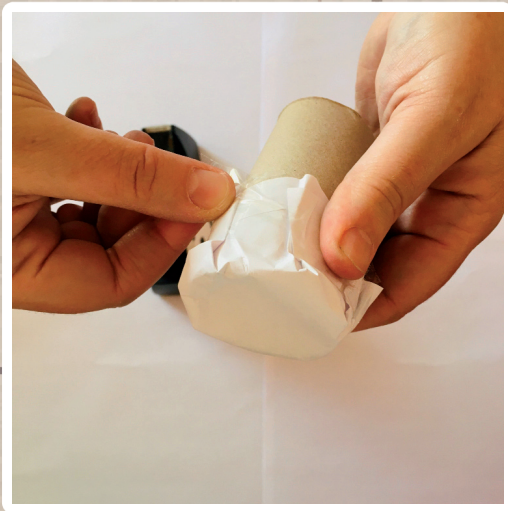
Stiff paper

Newspapers as underlay



\* We used food colouring for the photo. Of course, real natural dye is much more fun. For this, simmer the colouring plants for about twenty minutes and then pour them through a sieve. Beetroot, elderberries, blueberries, spinach, onion peel, curcuma, ... they all are wonderful dyes.

# Let's go!

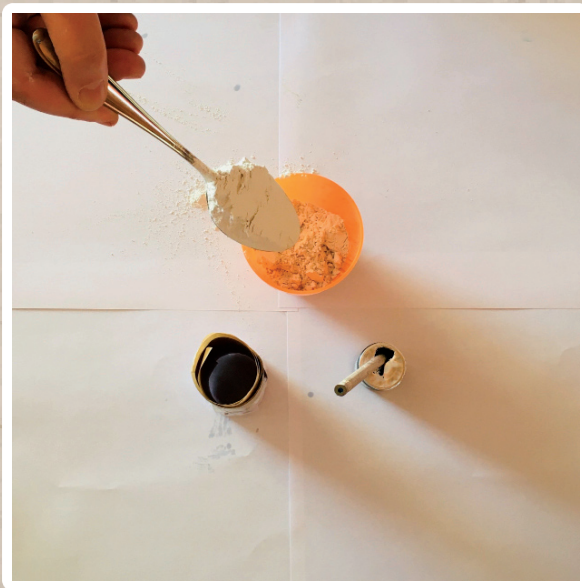


Use adhesive tape to attach firm paper as a „base“ to the toilet paper roll

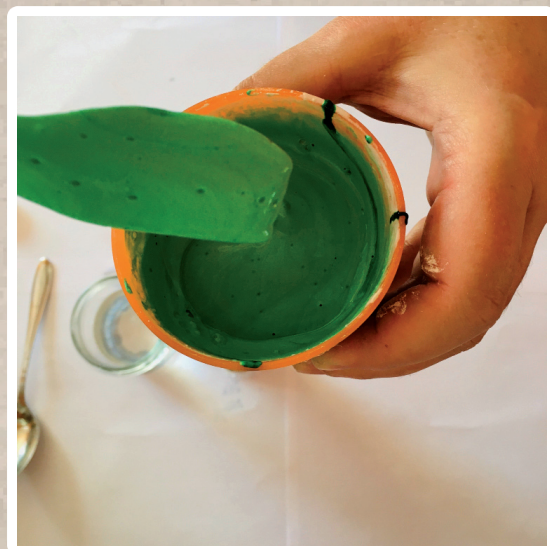
Spread newspapers as underlay



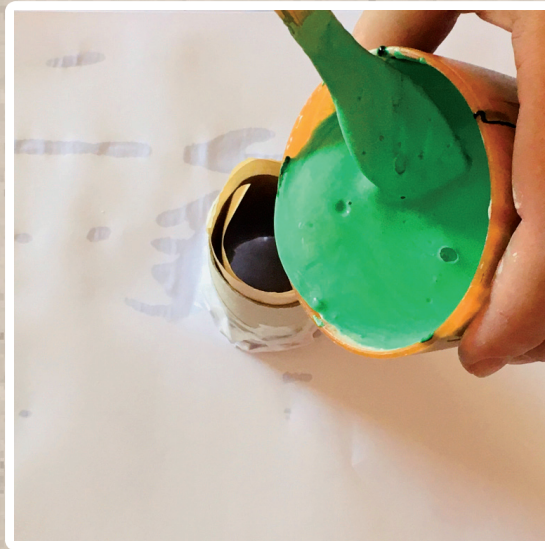
Roll up the baking paper strips and place in the toilet paper roll



Put the model plaster into a vessel



Pour the natural colour on the plaster and stir carefully until the mixture has the consistency of thin cake batter



Pour the mixture into the toilet paper roll



Let it dry in order to become firm for one or two hours

Remove the sidewalk chalk carefully from the roll and let it dry for about 12 hours
