


What makes tigers paw-some?

Color the pictures below while learning the cool cat facts




✓ Tigers are the largest wild cat in the world. Siberian tigers can weigh up to 400 kg.

Why are tigers an endangered species:




People illegally kill or catch an animal to make money.

Meet lioness Andi

Quick facts:

- Born in 2011 at a zoo in a country called Romania.
- Two young girls wanted to use her for photoshoots with tourists on the beach.
- She arrived at LIONSROCK in July 2012.

For the first few years of her life Andi was bounced between people who wanted to use her to make money and others who tried to give her a good home, but couldn't. Unfortunately, the keeping conditions were very cruel and Andi spent around 20 hours a day inside a very small room, completely alone. That's no way for a lion to live!

After FOUR PAWS was asked to help, she was rescued and brought to LIONSROCK Big Cat Sanctuary where she now lives a good life in a species-appropriate forever home.

Did you know?

Lions have spots on their fur when they are born! Lion cubs are actually born with a greyish woolly coat, with dark spots covering most of the back, legs and, face. These spots act as camouflage and help cubs blend into their surroundings making them almost invisible in bushes or long grass.
