

REVEAL, RESCUE, PROTECT


Our vision is for a world where people treat animals with respect, empathy and understanding. We are committed to revealing animal suffering and rescuing animals in need worldwide and providing them a species-appropriate home at our sanctuaries.

With 13 sanctuaries an active presence in 30 countries worldwide, FOUR PAWS provides rapid support and long-term solutions for animals in need.

Our sustainable campaigns and projects focus on companion animals, including stray dogs and cats, animals used in fashion, farmed animals and wild animals - such as bears, big cats, orangutans and elephants - kept in inappropriate conditions as well as in disaster and conflict zones.

Our global community enables us to rescue animals in need worldwide, ending the suffering of animals with continuing help and medical care. We are actively committed to humane and kinder treatment of stray dogs and cats, as well as to better keeping conditions for companion and farmed animals. We establish and operate sanctuaries worldwide, providing speciesappropriate homes for wild animals who have been rescued from abusive captivity.

FOUR PAWS takes a problem-solving approach and offers animals in distress swift and direct aid. Our aim is to achieve and establish changes in politics, society and the economy that will benefit all animals through projects, campaigns and education. Our work is based on scientific expertise, sound research and intensive national and international lobbying.



YOUR GIFT WILL PROTECT ANIMALS AROUND THE WORLD



WILD ANIMALS

Bears locked in small cages for people's entertainment or painful bile extraction, lions kept in breeding farms for the trade of their cubs and body parts, and orphaned orangutans who urgently need care who we train to live independently in their natural jungle habitat – all over the world, FOUR PAWS helps wild animals in distress. We take direct action to rescue them and provide a safe home in one of our sanctuaries.





STRAY ANIMALS

Millions of animals are left to fend for themselves on the streets in Southeast Asia and Eastern Europe. No cat or dog chooses to live half-starved, at risk of disease and injury. We provide the care to animal in desperate need, including veterinary care, food and spaying and neutering to reduce the number of animals born on the streets, and vaccinations to protect them from disease. These dogs and cats are no different to the ones who share our homes, by working with local partners and communities, we find their forever homes.

THE DOG AND CAT MEAT TRADE

While many of us love and care for our pets, there are many dogs and cats who are not so lucky. Every day in Cambodia, Indonesia and Vietnam, dogs and cats are stolen, either from the street or from loving families, leaving their owners desperate for their return. The animals are then taken to slaughterhouses and markets to be brutally killed for their meat. FOUR PAWS is committed to ending the cat and dog meat trade Southeast Asia, rescuing animals closing down slaughter farms and re-homing the animals or reuniting them with their owners.

WARS AND CONFLICT ZONES

FOUR PAWS operates a rapid response, highly skilled expert unit equipped to help animals in the face of wars or in conflict zones. Our veterinarians, rescue workers and crisis managers are trained to work under extremely challenging circumstances - wherever we're needed. In Ukraine, we have brought bears to safety and provided vital aid to animals in zoos in the face of energy shortages, supply disruptions and bombardment. It's just one of the urgent missions we are undertaking around the world.

SANCTURIES


Our 13 sanctuaries give animals a home where they can recover from trauma and live safely. Animals who have been in captivity for a long time often lose the ability to survive in the wild. Our sanctuaries are purposefully designed to replicate natural environments so they rediscover their instincts. Experienced animal caretakers provide daily stimulation to aid in their recovery from behavioural issues, and an expert medical team create tailor-made plans to ease their physical progress.



FARMED ANIMALS

Sadly, the livestock industry is a huge cause of immense animal suffering. It's estimated that over 80 billion animals worldwide are kept for food for humans, in a system that's largely protected by law, yet offers minimal animal welfare protections. The many cases of poor conditions and handling also increases the risk of viruses that can spread to humans (like Covid-19). FOUR PAWS has been working tirelessly to improve the lives of farmed animals, from lobbying for better breeding and housing conditions, to calling for urgent change to the transport and slaughter of cows, sheep, pigs and poultry.





ADVOCACY

We find real solutions for animals in need. Through lobbying and campaigns we help people understand the impact of animal mistreatment - and the political. social and economic benefits of changing the way we treat animals. In Australia, we encourage people to embrace plant-based food and make animal-friendly choices when buying clothes. We continue to push for better regulation to improve animal welfare, including an import ban on fur products, greater protection of hens abused in the egg industry and for puppies in the puppy farming trade, and ending the ongoing suffering within the live export trade.

PROTECTING DOGS AND CATS

Every day in Southeast Asia, pet dogs and cats are stolen and traded for their meat. They are sent to slaughterhouses and markets where they are brutally killed. Other animals live asstrays on the street, enduring hunger, disease and injury. FOUR PAWS is committed to ending these terrible abuses against dogs and cats around the world. We track them down and give food, medical care, sterilise and vaccinate them. With your help, we can do more to stop their suffering. **Scan the QR code or find out more.**

RESCUED BEAR VOVA

20-year-old brown bear Vova had spent years locked up in a tiny concrete cage outside a restaurant in Khmelnitsky region in Western Ukraine.

In November 2021, the keeping of bears next to restaurants was forbidden by law in Ukraine. Immediately, FOUR PAWS set in motion a plan and contacted the responsible authorities to order a confiscation so that Vova could be rescued.

A team of external FOUR PAWS partners transferred Vova to BEAR SANCTUARY Domazhyr, where Vova is finally living the life he deserves.

TRAPPED TIGERS TOUCH GRASS FOR THE FIRST TIME

For 15 years, tigers Sandro, Mafalda, Gustavo and Messi were kept illegally in a 75 square metre train carriage in Argentina.

Forced to exist in cramped and unsanitary conditions, the family of tigers had no room to run, play or bathe. When authorities were alerted and looked for solutions, FOUR PAWS immediately offered to help. After meticulous planning, FOUR PAWS safely flew the tigers to our LIONSROCK Big Cat Sanctuary in South Africa. Here the tigers felt grass under their paws for their first time. Now, they have plenty of trees and space to roam, a swimming pool, and a platform to view the sky – unobstructed by bars. Finally, they know peace.

KAAVAN THE WORLD'S LONELIEST ELEPHANT

Kaavan, the Asian Elephant, suffered for 35 years. His enclosure at Marghazar Zoo, Pakistan was inadequate and dangerous. After his beloved companion's death, Kaavan spent the next eight years completely isolated and chained, becoming known as the World's Loneliest Elephant. In 2020, thanks to a long-time supporter, Cher's Free the Wild organisation, we were able to rescue Kaavan in FOUR PAWS heaviest rescue mission to date. Flown to Cambodia's Wildlife Sanctuary to live the life he deserves, Kaavan is now free of chains and lives among his own kind. He spends his days exploring the sanctuary's jungle, water holes, mud pits and a pool with his three new elephant friends.


HELP CHANGE THE LIVES OF FARMED ANIMALS

Some of the worst abuses on animals happen in agriculture. We've been working for decades to shine a light on some of the terrible practices around breeding, transport and slaughter of animals. We actively promote animal-free consumer choices and push for better regulation and oversight.

EASING THE SUFFERING OF ANIMALS IN AGRICULTURE

Animal suffering in agricultural and livestock industries can be truly shocking. The reality of life for chickens, pigs, sheep and cows is often unrelenting suffering – forced to reproduce and grow fast, to live in overcrowded and diseased conditions, and transported and slaughtered cruelly. Sheep undergo painful mulesing practices, when pain-free solutions to flystrike are available. These practices may keep production cheap for consumers and businesses, but the true cost is borne by the animals, the environment – and our health. We work tirelessly to improve animal welfare through our political lobbying and our campaign to urge the Government and local authorities to #MakeFoodKinder. This is an important mission and one that can change the lives of millions of animals – and we need your help to make it happen.

Once you've made your decision, it is simple to leave a gift to FOUR PAWS. Here's how.



SPEAK TO FAMILY AND LOVED ONES

While the decision to leave a gift in your Will is very personal, we recommend that you tell the people closest to you of your wishes.

MAKE OR UPDATE YOUR WILL

Leaving a gift in your Will is much easier than many people think. To draw up a new Will, either talk to your lawyer or use a do-it-yourself Will kit provided by the Public Trustee in your state.

UK has partnered with Bequeathed, an expert Will writing service that will guide you through what is largely a stress-free, quick and effortless process. You can make your Will online for free and from the comfort of your home.

If you already have a Will, you may choose to speak to your Will provider or Solicitor about adding a codicil. A codicil is simply an amendment to your Will that alters, explains, adds to, or otherwise updates it in any way.





HOW TO WORD YOUR INTENTION

Suggested wording you might find useful to discuss with your solicitor:

I GIVE [x% of my Residuary Estate OR the sum of £x] to FOUR PAWS UK. Registered charity number 1118102 of 7-14 Great Dover Street, London, SE1 4YR, for its charitable purposes.



DECIDE THE GIFT TYPE OR AMOUNT

Whichever is right for you, you can leave your gift to FOUR PAWS UK in one of four ways:

- By nominating a percentage of what is left after you've provided for your family and loved ones
- By nominating a percentage or fraction of your estate
- By nominating a specific gift
- Or by fixed asset, such as shares or property

Inform us of your gift

We would love if you could let us know that you have included FOUR PAWS UK in your Will so that we can thank you personally. Any information that you choose to share with us regarding your Will is completely confidential.
