A few ways YOU can #LiveKinder this summer:




-  If you see trash lying around when visiting the beach, a dam, a park, or anywhere else, pick it up and throw it in a bin.

-  Try not to visit places where animals can be touched or where you pay to pose with them for a photo.










Take good care of them even during the holidays!



How to take good care of pets in summer...

Always make sure they have cold and clean water to drink in a clean bowl.




Never leave pets in the car - even for five minutes. They can get so hot, they can die!

Pets should have a shady area or be able to get in the house where they can get out of the sun.



Don't take your dog for a walk if it's too hot - their paws can burn and they can get sick!



How do you know if it's too hot?


Touch the pavement, road or sand with your hands or bare feet. If your hand burns, their paws will also burn.

Help keep pets safe this summer!

Keep your holiday food away from animals. Foods with chocolate, xylitol (fake sugar), onions, garlic, alcohol, and raisins can be very dangerous for animals, especially dogs.



Red poinsettias (those pretty red flowers we often see in the shops in December) are dangerous to cats and dogs. The same goes for Peace Lillies. Make sure your pets can reach them!

Keep your gift wrapping and decorations far away from your pets. Strings, tinsel, glass ornaments are all things that can hurt them.



Make sure animals can't reach the food bins to eat old or bad food! Chicken or fish bones, and spicy or creamy foods can make them sick and hurt their tummies.

And something important to remember Animal Heroes:

Have your vet's telephone number up on the fridge where everyone can see it in case of an emergency – and if you are going on holiday or visiting family and taking your pet with you, make sure you know who the local vet is.



Did you know?

Lions usually live in groups of 10 or 15 animals called prides. Lions are also the only big cats to live in prides and they use these groups to work together to defend their home, take care of one another and to hunt for food.
