Stray Animal Care Program

Ukraine is home to around 50,000 stray animals, living without a home and in dire need of vet treatment.

Due to the ongoing conflict, this number is expected to grow with animals suffering from injury or disease, like rabies. Disease is easily spread among strays, and without neutering, uncontrolled breeding can quickly lead to overpopulation.

FOUR PAWS launched its Stray Animal Care (SAC) program in 2012 with the aim to treat ill and injured stray animals whilst also humanely neutering them.

Since February 2022, our SAC team have supplied two shelters in Ukraine with enough food to feed over 300 dogs for at least a month.

1. Heat the vegetable oil in a large saucepan, add the carrot, celery and onion and cook gently for a few minutes.
2. Add the beetroot, potato and garlic and fry for a couple of minutes, until well coated and combined.
3. Add the stock and season with salt and black pepper. Bring to the boil and then simmer for 15 minutes.
4. Add the cabbage and tomatoes. Cover and leave to simmer for a further 20 minutes.
5. Serve your soup with a sprinkling of dill to finish and enjoy!



Serves 4 - Ingredients

- 1 tbsp vegetable oil
- 1 carrot, diced
- 1 celery stick, diced
- 1 onion, diced
- 3 medium beetroots (450g), peeled and diced
- 1 large waxy potato, diced
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 ½ pints vegetable stock
- ½ purple cabbage, finely shredded
- 2 tomatoes, peeled, cored and chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Dill for garnish
