# Re: ASEAN Leaders' Declaration on One Health Initiative

Dear H.E. Dr. Kao Kim Hourn,

We are writing on behalf of the **Asia for Animals Coalition**, a network of local and international animal protection and conservation organizations as well as other international animal welfare organizations promoting the One Health approach to enable health for all.

We would like to express our gratitude for the ASEAN Leaders' *Declaration on One Health Initiative*, recently issued at the 42nd ASEAN summit.<sup>1</sup> This statement represents a bold commitment that emphasizes the health and wellbeing of animals and ecosystems.

We very much welcome this significant and commendable step that underscores the importance of a collaborative and multisectoral approach, recognizing the interconnectedness of human, animal, plant, and environmental health and wellbeing. The declaration lays the foundation for enhanced coordination, cooperation, communication, and multisectoral collaboration among and within ASEAN member states following a whole-of-society and whole-of-government approach, which is required to tackle health threats, including zoonotic pathogens, antimicrobial resistance, and other challenges to human and animal lives, ecosystems, and livelihoods.

We applaud the ASEAN Leaders' efforts to include primary prevention addressing the root causes and drivers of zoonoses at source, improved preparedness, and timely response to health threats. As guided by the One Health Joint Plan of Action (OHJPA) and the work of the One Health High Level Expert Panel (OHHLEP), including their recent definition of zoonotic spillover 'prevention', we encourage ASEAN to lay emphasis on primary prevention of zoonotic outbreaks and pathogen spillover from animals to humans.<sup>2,3</sup>

This can be done by addressing the root causes and drivers of disease (re)emergence such as ending high-risk practices and promoting basic animal and human health and animal welfare practices, which
