The Will to help animals

FOUR PAWS is an international animal welfare organisation with offices in 14 countries, and a headquarters in Vienna, Austria. Founded by Heli Dungler in 1988, the organisation strives to improve animal welfare around the world through campaigns, lobbying, projects, programmes and wildlife rescues. We concentrate on animals directly under human control, for example: farm animals, wild animals, and companion animals that are kept under poor conditions, and who are being abused/exploited by man. We work to help animals in need directly and rapidly, while finding and creating sustainable solutions to improve their lives. In South Africa we focus on big cats, specifically the lion.

LIONSROCK Big Cat Sanctuary

LIONSROCK Big Cat Sanctuary, a project by FOUR PAWS provides a life-long species appropriate habitat for big cats that were kept in poor conditions. Many of these big cats were rescued from zoos, circuses, war-torn disaster areas, and private captivity from around the world. Situated in the Free State and stretched over 1250 hectares of magnificent African landscape, LIONSROCK is home to nearly 100 big cats and other South African wild species. At LIONSROCK animals receive the highest care and medical treatment possible and enjoy greater autonomy to live out the rest of their lives where they are safe and free from harm.
